PDT – Statistics



- 16 Committers (13 from Zend and 3 from IBM)
- 62 Bugzilla reporters
- 1060 newsgroup messages
- More than 40,000 downloads a month (Eclipse Statistics)
- Bugs:

	Critical	Major	Normal	Minor	Enhancement	Total
Open	0	15	40	16	53	124
Resolved	3	4	7	5	1	20
Closed	25	144	206	21	4	414
Total	28	163	253	42	58	558

What do we do?



- Develop a PHP development tool framework which contains:
 - Inspection Data
 - Syntax Highlighting
 - Code Assist
 - Debugging
 - PHP Templates
 - PHPDoc Inspection and Creation
 - And more...
- Delivered as Nightly, Integration, Milestone and RC Builds
- Unit testing and RSS
- Build a PHP community around Eclipse
