Input

- **Sources**
 - Seven Strategic developers and consumers
 - Three Project Management Committees (PMCs)
 - 10+ projects
 - 30+ member companies
 - Meeting in Fort Worth, TX
 - 8 discussion topics selected by member companies
 - Number of votes determined priority
- **Form**
 - Prioritized list of requirements
 - Varying granularity



Processing

- **Synthesized inputs into themes**
- **Add-in provider input weighted proportional to representation at Eclipse board of directors**
- **Relentless refinement and re-factoring through active participation of Requirements Council**



Output

- Strategic member companies, Eclipse projects, and general member companies on the same page
- Folks involved with Eclipse for 3-4 years agreed that the themes “made sense”
- Themes guide architecture, planning, resource allocation
 - Scaling Up theme used to focus on performance improvement
- Newsgroup discussion
