




- A self-selecting audience: Those who chose to subscribe to a free quarterly magazine about Eclipse development

- This presentation primarily shows my poor PowerPoint skills




# *What stage are you with building apps w/Eclipse?*




# *What type of apps are you making with Eclipse?*






