
Project Goals

- Deliver a PHP Integrated Development Environment extensible framework for the Eclipse Platform
- Encompass the development components necessary to develop PHP-based Web Applications
- Leverage the existing Web Tools Project in providing developers with PHP capabilities.

Project Scope

- The project will contribute an initial set of Eclipse plug-ins that will add PHP IDE capabilities to Eclipse, and will provide APIs to further extend the functionality of the project.
- The project will be composed of a set of extensible features covering the development life cycle of PHP including functionality that deals with developing, deploying, documenting and debugging PHP-based applications
