- Transition to Eclipse Foundation Update
 - Adoptium/AQAvit repos have approval for initial creation, Temurin still need CQs (details at <https://github.com/AdoptOpenJDK/TSC/issues/205> owners needed)
 - Plan to create the Adoptium/AQAvit repos in the Adoptium org during our code freeze in prep for next week's release. Immediately after release, switch over to use new Adoptium repos and shift AdoptOpenJDK repos to read-only. Temurin repos will get shifted later (after CQs created and moved to approved state)
