Minutes

Approval of Minutes and Review of Actions from April 29, 2021

Approved

State of AdoptOpenJDK Transition/ 1st Temurin Release

- Still waiting on Oracle to sign the "three-way agreement" for Red Hat and Ben Evans' access to the JCK material as part of Temurin compliance project. This is rapidly becoming the critical path to achieving the July release of Temurin.
- Eclipse staff continue to seek Oracle's countersignature. In the meantime the infrastructure is being established at the project.
- PR to add first TCK machines (tracking here https://github.com/adoptium/adoptium/issues/3)
- Holding off on the docker repo for now until we get a path to producing binaries.
- Need to discuss the install-jdk GitHub action.
- The Adoptium TLP PMC has set May 26th set as goal for Milestone 1 (windows, linux and macOS). This is a necessary goal to achieve the July release.
- Does the temurin-compliance mentor need to sign the 3-way agreement?

 Sharon explained that a mentor need not be a committer on the project, therefore this would not be necessary.
- Are we going to ship detached GPG signatures for our binaries?
 - Likely yes, as that is the most consumable format for a sig.

Website design

- Invoice for the Adoptium logo has been sent to EF and is being handled.
- ZHAW students on final sprint as part of their website implementation.
- AdoptOpenJDK/website-adoptium: Repo for new Adoptium website
- Still need a response from the EF creative team on their bid for website design.
 Getting close to the part where a design is required to apply to the ZHAW student dev work.

Budget Update
