 - Paul Buck Asked George if Microsoft has enough time to get paperwork completed by the date of the press release. George says hopefully paperwork will be signed today.
- Membership Update & Pipeline
 - Paul Buck Contacting Fujitsu. Huawei (best working with Tim Ellison) to engage in new project activities, and thereby lead to inclusion interest in the working group.
 - Eclipse following up on a number of prospects for the next round of members.
 - Consider including in the pipeline organizations listed on AdoptOpenJDK user page (<u>https://adoptopenjdk.net/users.html</u>) either as "Adopters" or as potential sponsors/members.

 - JetBrains are an interesting prospect. Potential for interest based upon the Android-specific JDK. Plan to arrange an informal contact with Trisha first to determine a way forward.
 - George will revisit ZHAW University as a potential member of the Working Group, even if Andreas not interested in being on the steering committee.
- Search for the Adoptium Community Manager
 - Paul reminded that the search may be protracted. He asked people to continue reviewing the role specification before it is posted.
 - Eclipse will appreciate some collaboration on selecting the best candidate when the time comes.

- Adoptium WG logo and website
 - Final version of the logo has been selected
 - \circ Request "version 1" go forward for trademark search
 - Sharon's recommendation is to produce the final logo version before submitting to search. We will do this before asking the design agency to produce supporting material.
 - Sharon will check whether we need to go to registration with the greyscale version or black and white version.
- Eclipse Foundation Program Plan & Budget Process
 - Paul explained the program planning and budgeting process at Eclipse.
 - Reference materials are available in the <u>Adoptium SC shared drive folder</u> in GSuite.
- AOB
 - Red Hat will sponsor 1 summer intern for Eclipse Adoptium/AQAvit from the Outreachy program. We are very excited to participate in Outreachy and see that it will grow diversity at the project. Shelley has submitted Eclipse Adoptium as a community at Outreachy (see

https://www.outreachy.org/communities/cfp/eclipse-adoptium/) and will coordinate the process, and submitted 2 project proposals which candidates will apply and compete for. Adding extra info for Thabang, as he suggested we publicize, (celebrate!)... This along with our current involvement with CanOSP program (canosp.ca,

https://canosp.ca/2021/01/25/w21-code-sprint/) and the ZHAW student project means we will have 3 different programs that bring new collaborators and talent to the project
