Minutes:

Approval of minutes from May 25th, 2023 meeting

Minutes of the meeting were approved as written.

The WG SC welcomed Thabang to the meeting as an Eclipse Foundation member with marketing responsibilities.

Informational: Canonical (Samir) joined as Enterprise member

- Carmen informed the working group that Canonical have joined the WG as an Enterprise member.
- We will arrange a welcome and onboarding for Canonical reps in the coming days.

Informational: RISE effort in RISC-V community

- This is an effort to bring up projects on RISC-V architecture. Includes support and hardware for this effort.
- Ludovic is helping to promote Adoptum in this forum as OpenJDK is a target.

EF Infrastructure services and effort review

- Carmen shared the infrastructure review slides, including companies providing paid-for services, and a chart showing which machines have some level of Eclipse Infrastructure involvement.
- Tim noted that there is a full list of the project's infrastructure dependency in the infra repository inventory. These are predominantly configured via Ansible, and monitored via Nagios.

- Shelley asked if the EF infra team are using the same Ansible playbooks to manage TCK machines administered by them? Also noted that we wish to push towards using further dynamic provisioning of machines.
 - Stewart advised the SC that the playbooks used by the Eclipse Foundation infra team are copies of the project's playbooks, but are different. The SC noted that communication is key to ensuring that there is no gratuitous divergence and introduction of technical debt by having different playbooks. Communication between the EF infra team and project is predominantly at release time, but may benefit from further cadence. Paul B offered to help set up appropriately.
 - Short discussion on the value of increasing the momentum towards dynamically provisioned machines - example being QEMU RISC-V machines where real hardware is hard to achieve.
