Regular Steering Committee Update (Thomas)

- New members pipeline: Preparation of presentations in some member prospect companies; additional new prospects extracted from "top contributors" list
- Updated pitch deck continuously being improved.
- Waiting for feedback on loongarch support from requesting company.

IDE WG Charter Update - Three Main Sentences

Initial feedback incorporated in draft.

Additional feedback discussed regarding JDT and its importance.

Proposal by Martin: Before updating the website, share draft with wider community (non-working-group-members) in order to provide feedback.

Unanimously agreed, will use GitHub discussion to share the draft and get feedback.

Thomas has prepared drafts for Java and RCP SIGs as well as a cross-wg tooling modernization IG.
