- Lots of actions in the 'Expand Ecosystem' are done
- Needs attention : <u>Sponsorship project</u>,
- Risk : <u>code day students onboarding</u>
- Top progress : connection with other community (jakarta EE...), IDE is part of all marketing messages, EF newsletter. 2 articles in java pro
- Copilot Eclipse integration : is now ok
- Membership pipeline : 15 in progress with active discussions
- Releases : 2024 09 : 2 343 000 downloads, 2025 03 : 482 000 (in progress). Values are now correct

Graphs

- New metrics for 2025-03 : data are still private because not anonymized. Nb of authors, new authors and contributors based on 60 projects.
- Graph of number of commit by organization : more than 1000 in December and January 25. -> in Q4 2024 > 3500 commits.
- Graph of number of issues : around 400 issues per month since December
- Graph of number of commits/issues per projects : some of them have no contributions.
