Shanda presenting and explaining a new menu item structure (option 2 in the gitlab issue)

Continue discussion and recommendations on the GitLab issue (basically the result of our quick discussion here to merge the pages)

No objections to moving ahead in this direction (putting the Eclipse IDE in the front and center of https://eclipseide.org)

EclipseCon Community Day Activities

IDE WG Development Efforts

Paul provides an update: fixes for dark theme, contractor (John Moule) started to work on the issues, John makes progress with assistance from Jonah, extended the contract on the timeline.

Martin and John will continue to support / mentor / monitor the activities.

Webinars / Community Engagement

Pradeep: came up with an initial set of topics/sessions and speakers for those initial set of sessions, could start in September for webinars. Will create a wiki page for the webinar topics, collect the content, then schedule those sessions for the upcoming slots

The wiki page will include some process-related topics as well. This was motivated by this example:

Pradeep: gives a summary about feedback from the team about the number of bugs being filed is going down, the process of filing bugs got more complicated on GitHub (login/account required, find the right repo, etc.) - brainstorming ideas to make it easier for people for create issues

GitHub Sponsors Pilot

Paul provides a summary (slides can be found here:)

Questions for the WG: Do we want to do this? Do we want to try this? Which projects to support?

Pradeep: Why should we not do it?

Paul: An interesting question will be to have an idea about how to spend the donations from GitHub Sponsor, for which project, and how to spread the donations among projects

Pradeep: this is probably a good problem to have... :-)

Ed: Do the projects want to donate buttons and let the money go to the IDE WG? How would the WG spend the money?

General agreement that the projects themselves should drive / decide where the money how and where the money should be spent. Existing process with the planning council seems to be okay-ish, probably need to emphasize this.
