## Minutes for Dec 10, 2024

Approve Minutes of November 26, 2024 Meeting

 Motion: Approve Minutes of November 26, 2024. Jorg moves and Mark seconds. No objection to unanimous approval.

RESOLVED, the Steering Committee unanimously approved the Minutes of November 26 2024.

Program plan and budget approved as it is.

Anticipating the similar setup to before with the hybrid session at the end. Thomas intends to set up meetings ahead of time to get priorities for members not able to travel.

Ed presents his session on SimRel and other work and what is involved and what has been improved.

Ed's role is important for problem prevention. Works hard on getting ahead of possible future problems. E.g. #2623 and Java 24 problems.

Jorg has some big concerns regarding only Ed knowing this work.

Thomas: Follow up on Initiative 31. 4 companies in our pipeline and 8 new companies not known so far. In addition 12 people are interested in contributing. This is a good result following the call. Thomas has added some new tags to the pipeline board to help track interest areas such as Initiative 31 and Marketplace contributor, etc.

Planning council priorities:

GTK work is important but cannot fund it from inside the WG. Companies need to jump in and assist.

https://github.com/eclipse-ide entry point for new contributors. Work in progress but lots of useful content on this space. We should communicate more on this.

Initiative 31 had 2 additional attendees in the weekly meeting.

GTK4 support - most people are interested in Skia. So companies that need this really need to step up.

Sponsorship - idea to have another call to discuss this in detail.

Mark keen to join this.

Sebastian: Frequency of the page popping up?

Thomas reminds us to discuss this as Individual sponsorship?

Manoj would like to join, Ed too.

Feedback from the Foundation on the donation rate. What has changed and when? Ed has changed to open the Foundation sponsorship page for this release.

Thomas will start to cover this on a quarterly update report.. Different currencies and analyzing the data is needed.
