### IDE WG Dev Effort: Sharon

- On-boarded Manoj for the sub-committee.
- Highest priority is issue 19 - onboarding mentor for new comers
- Two ongoing contracts - 15, 33 (releng)
- All other identified dev efforts remain paused
- Renesas platinum membership helped
- 2024 budget re-forecast in progress - Early April
- 2025 budget projections - funding possible for the consultant
