Thomas Update

- Community mentors
 - New landing page in review
 - Automated version increments should be usable for next release
 - Simplification of Oomph setup configuration in progress
 - Students have started working on good first issues. Will take time but they're prime subjects to become Eclipse committers
 - Linux GTK4 first step should've been done, but deadline extended to the end of the year. His work is probably only available by March 2025
 - Alexander Kurtakov expects that the most adventurous OS's wil start dropping gtk3 (webkitgtk) binding in their spring releases. This will break browsers: help, hover, etc.
- Jonah has resigned from th dev funding committee and as the planning council chair
- Please take a look at the program plan 2024 and 2025 preparation
- The Community Day had 66 registered attendees 30-35 live attendees
- Eclipse IDE Overview MASTER is the main pitch deck now
- Zara will handle the Steering Committee committer elections. Results by the end of the wekk

Initiative 31

- Overview of what will be presented at OCX & the call to action
- Swing prototype allows theming, but application and browser are quite broken
- Skia using the LibreOffice widget kit was unfeasible
- Pure Skia was expected to be too much effort, but actually surprisingly simple and can be done incrementally. For example, a single button can be drawn using SKIA while the rest is SWT
- Overall insights: low specific knowledge should be preferred (e.g. only Java)
- Graphics engine and widget implementation should be separated to allow easy swapping out
- Full effort guestimation is hardly possible.
- GTK has many possible blockers
- Swing is in maintenance mode
- For Skia it's unknown how long it'll take but has the best flexibility
- Will try to implement a full widget to see how long the entire transformation would take
- Skia looks the most interesting now, but the others might still be interesting
- CTA: let's share efforts and find a common way to modernize Eclipse IDE applications

- Community call after OCX to look for community help, more help is required to finish the modernization
- A company is also working on a similar Skia approach and might approach Initiative 31

Program Plan Review

- Steering committee program meeting at OCX on Thursday morning
- Other meetings in mid and end november to finish the plan and budget
- We want to find *measurable goals* for the strategy
- We used to have 9 strategy goals, now we'll go for 5. They're mostly similar but grouped

- Many people requested AI
