# Approve Minutes of Feb 4, 2025 Meeting

## Attendance

- Tanja Obradovic attends as guest
  - Leads Java group at Eclipse foundation discussing topics related to Java projects (including JakartaEE, Adoptium, ...)
  - Eclipse IDE WG may be involved there

Thomas regular steering committee update

- New direct contacts and one company expressed interested to join WG
- First open community meetup takes place in Bangalore at 26th March
- Eclipse IDE is represented at Devnexus (by Olivier Prouvost)
- Eclipse IDE will be represented at Embedded World
- Ongoing discussions with Microsoft about the just provided Eclipse Copilot integration maybe becoming open source and being integrated into SimRel

# Updated priorities

- Thomas proposes re-prioritization based on the existing program plan (highlighting top priorities, lower priorities and dropped objectives)
- Keep 2025 plan as is (2/3 SimRel, 1/3 growth)
  - Main focus on value part of program strategic goals (bare minimum)
  - Only secondary focus on growth part of program strategic goals, even though we see investments here (more committers, projects being started)
- WG companies have significant revenue, still not able to manage to get sufficient money for WG
  - On the other side, there are many others depending on Eclipse/IDE not contributing anything at all
- Different ways for finding more sources of revenue need to be discussed
- Program plan details:
  - LSP next level: no actions defined and dropped for now
    - Work already being done (e.g., CDT)

- To support this, WG companies will need to invest; no funds available from WG and nothing to be supported by funded dev efforts
- Contributor recognition: reduced priority
- Innovation tasks reduced in priority, but not much action taken on it yet anyway
- Potential replacement for community mentors: people involved in Initiative 31?
- In-app sponsorship: initially contributed by Wayne, waiting for other contributors
  - https://github.com/eclipse-oomph/oomph/issues/134#issuecomment-26975606

  - WG still needs to investigate what we can expect regarding sponsoring, what we achieved in the past
  - Currently unclear who is waiting for whom, so set up another call for pushing sponsorship topic
  - Eclipse Foundation currently revamps sponsorship program
- Agreement:
  - No direct objections on proposed re-prioritization
  - Still offline review and double-check on feedback
  - Finally agree on it next meeting

Webinar proposal

- Options proposed by Thomas: raising the alarm, modernization presentation, inspirational talk
- Target audience: so far, mostly developers were involved (not so much decision makers)
  - Better present achievements than raising the alarm
  - Inspirational talks may be interesting
  - Still use the chance to raise the alarm as well?
  - Agreement on having a webinar but no agreement on contents -> Gitlab issue to discuss and find agreement on content
- If not in webinar: where to raise the alarm? We need to raise it now
