## **Marketing Updates**

Hassan Jaber gave a quick update on the edgeOps White paper impact which is now close to 1K downloads. The IoT & Edge commercial adoption survey report has had around 300 downloads after 2 weeks of being released. News about these reports have been published on 10+ media outlets.

## **Projects in WG scope (comitter rep election)**

Resolved, the ENWG steering committee considers the following projects as belonging to scope: Eclipse IoFog, Eclipse Fog05, Eclipse Zenoh.

Frederic Desbiens mentioned that we need to do a Project's comitter representative election, however the above mentioned projects are already represented in the steering committee.

Potential new projects that could be included in the ENWG scope need to show a mutual interest and pass an "edge-native categorization" test; this test will be defined afterwards.

# 2021 Program plan (progress update)

Kilton Hopkins elaborated on the way to achieve the planned objectives. Kilton proposed the ENWG should focus on the European market rather than in the US, Canada (North American) market for the time being. Hassan Jaber proposed this should be included on the marketing plan for 2022. Brainstorm of ideas circulated about hosting events and how to increase the visibility of the ENWG initiatives.
