

Eclipse Kuksa

Open Source Connected Car Platform

- Eclipse-Che-based [App IDE](#) to simplify & speed-up development activities
 - Use & enhance Automotive Grade Linux (AGL) App development SDK
 - Full-blown IDE for **Kuksa-AGL App & Springboot Cloud App development**
 - Simplify the usage of automotive APIs integrated through IDE support
- Service enablers for [car-to-cloud connectivity](#)
 - Network infrastructure considerations
 - Next generation mobile networks e.g. 5G
- Open source [in-vehicle platform](#)
 - Safe and secure gateway to the cloud
 - In-vehicle data access mechanism and application platform
- Establishment and use of [standardized vehicle IoT and Cloud interfaces](#) to and from the vehicle


