Ivar Grimstad

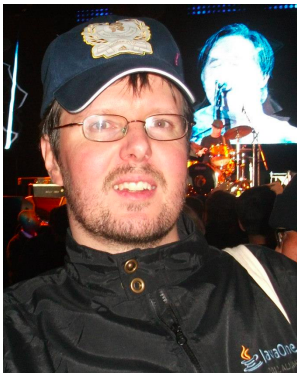


Ivar Grimstad works as Principal Consultant for Cybercom Group in Sweden. He is a Java Champion and well-known in the Java community.
