1 Presentation of NorCom

TA presents NorCom as the newest driver member of the openMDM WG.

2 Status Architecture & Quality Committees

AB presents the status of the architecture committee. The regular conference calls are continuing more frequently to resolve upcoming technology discussions. The lack of contributions to the discussions on the mailing lists is mentioned and discussed. Concerns about compatibility with operations and potentially show stopping decisions are raised. Furthermore, JW hints that the information in the technology document should be categorized and sorted. The AC will address these issues in the next conference call.

The QC is not present but reported to intensify its activities since the architecture specification is now available.

3 Services Status (GM)

The information about the status of services from the general assembly is briefly reviewed. The necessity to find a way for all members to provide their membership dues by means of a service is noted, especially after the withdrawal of HighQSoft's service to provide HQL.

The quality check service is discussed in detail. Since the QC has not yet signaled the availability of the quality conformance check, the content of such a service are still unknown. While the attendees agree that there must be a common description of integration and user





tests for all projects related to the working group, the place to specify the internal (unit) test remains unclear.

A hackathon at the EclipseCon Europe is proposed to provide an opportunity for participants of the working group to:

- Start coding in an open source environment
- Get to know the Eclipse Infrastructure (mentors will attend as well)
- Familiarize themselves with the architecture on a technical level
- Discuss the implementation of quality guidelines

RM will organize the invitation. The SC agrees to grant one day of member fee to each participating member for motivation.

The services which have not been transitioned to the openMDM Jira instance are transferred. The current status of the services is as follows:

4 Project Structure

The project structure is discussed. Especially the name "MDM@web" is misleading since the project will contain all types of MDM components. The new name MDM|COMPONENTS is agreed upon.

All specifications will be gathered in the MDM|BL project.

A new project, MDM|PLATFORM, is proposed which could hold the services required to operate an openMDM system, e.g. bootstrap service and authentication service. While these parts could be included in one of the existing project, they are most likely to be of interest for reuse by a broader audience since they will not contain domain specific functionality.

Overall, the project structure should be discussed in more detail considering its impact.

5 Miscellaneous

To achieve a regular release cycle, the projects need to adopt the Eclipse style with a fixed release date and ensure to release working code even if the whole scope cannot be met. The issues resulting from this approach are discussed.

The planning of individual project milestones will be done in the corresponding project meetings. The next project meeting for MDM@web is planned for mid of October.

6 Press Release

Since a press release about the general assembly will probably draw the attention of a broader audience. The release will be postponed until the website is updated. HighQSoft as the contractor of the website service will be asked to update the website as soon as possible.
