1. Release v0.11

The remaining MRs for the v0.11 has been merged. To finalize the release following steps has to be done:

- a. Merge the develop branch into the main branch
- b. Tag the new release v0.11
- c. Add release notes
- d. Build new documentation

2. Documentation structure

To improve the structure of the documentation a workshop will be planned.

3. AWS Marketplace

BMW has suggested hosting an openPASS instance on the AWS Marketplace. The purpose of this initiative is to offer new users a convenient and efficient cloud-based version of openPASS, eliminating the need for local installations. This one-click solution aims to provide easy access and fast deployment.

BMW is currently working on a proof of concept for this idea. As for future maintenance, the details are uncertain at this time.

To proceed with this plan, a seller account on the AWS Marketplace is required. BMW will cover the associated costs for the time being.

4. EclipseCON 2023

The proposal of the openPASS talk was accepted. Jan and Arun are refining the presentation.

5. ADAS Companion

On the SafetyWeek Jan was approached to publish an article about openPASS in the in the <u>ADAS Companion</u>. Jan is going to write a proposal.

6. EclipsePEDIA deprecation

Since Eclipsepedia will be deprecated in 2026. Tuan will contact the Eclipse Foundation if they can support in transferring the meeting minutes to GitLab, see https://gitlab.eclipse.org/eclipsefdn/helpdesk/-/issues/3380.

7. Planning V1.0

According to VW a first version of the GUI will be available end of July. With the first version it should be possible to set up and run a complete simulation with the GUI. Until now the opGUI repository is still empty. To prepare the release of the GUI and avoid any issues the first commit to the GitLab repository should happen towards the next AC.

The MantleAPI and the OpenSCENARIO Engine are a major part of v1.0.

The release of version 1.0 is being planned for end of August.
