- The ScalaModules project is a proposed open source project under the **Equinox Project**
- This project will create a **Scala DSL for OSGi**
- It will build on the **existing codebase** (1.x release) and enhance it further
- Graduation is planned with the **2.0 release** aligned with the **Helios release plan**

- ScalaModules is an existing project
  - Released in version 1.0 in March 2009, under active development towards version 2.0
  - Initially licensed under Apache License, Version 2.0

- ScalaModules will be moved to Eclipse completely
