  - o Discussion about expectation of participant members

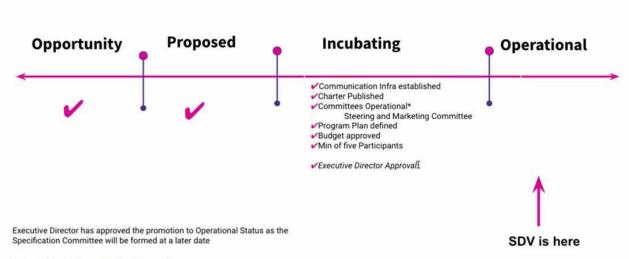

- Members of the Eclipse Foundation have a responsibility and obligation to comply with the Eclipse Foundation Antitrust Policy (<a href="https://www.eclipse.org/org/documents/Eclipse\_Antitrust\_Policy.pdf">https://www.eclipse.org/org/documents/Eclipse\_Antitrust\_Policy.pdf</a>) in order to comply with antitrust laws.
- These laws generally prohibit the following:
  - Price-Fixing
  - Agreements to Allocate Markets
  - Concerted Refusals to Deal
  - Exchange of competitively sensitive information
- All Working Group activities must be conducted in an open, transparent and vendor-neutral manner. In particular Working Group meetings must also comply with the following:
  - Provide meeting notices in advance
  - Provide meeting agendas in advance, and stick to the topics on the agenda
  - Provide accurate meeting minutes; including their approval and dissemination
  - Perform a periodic reminder of the Eclipse Foundation Antitrust Policy
