Dana gives an [overview regarding the maturity badges](#). There are five badges and three levels for each.

- Badges: Documentation, Requirements, Coding Guidelines, Testing, Release Process
- Levels: Bronze, Silver, Gold

The SDV badges will be hosted on the Eclipse Metrics website. They will also be computed automatically every night.

The attendees thank Dana for her work (representative of all involved parties) and appreciate the current results. Gunther and Martin note that we need to include automotive maturity/safety processes/norms in the future, such as ASPICE and ISO 26262. Dana says that this is a first step and we will have a handbook in the future for projects on how to adopt the WG processes. Furthermore, issues such as ASPICE, functional safety, cyber security and SOTIF will be considered in the future.

Dana also highlights that the participation of the community in the process work was rather limited so far. Dana highlights the importance of sending suitable people from the organizations who are knowledgeable and work in the field of functional safety.

Moreover, icons have been created for the different badges and levels. Daniel mentions that there may be room for improvements. Gunther proposes to use the infinity icon for the Release Process badges.
