- Community day at Graz
  - Hosted by AVL
  - 1,5 day duration
  - Good participation and intensive discussion in the hands on session
  - Badges program will be started to document quality maturity of projects
  - IAM (independent aftermarket): Access to vehicle data is key to stay in the business
- Community day at Detroit
  - Hosted by GM
  - o 60 participants
  - Combination of local people and experts from Europe
  - Good atmosphere
  - Positively received by participants

- Big interest in SDV topic was visible
- Question: follow up to Steven
  - Yearly Hackathon
  - Yearly community day
- Embedded World (Nuremberg)
  - Thread X was of great interest to community
  - Important point: Questions came also from SDV member organisations. This means that internal communication has to be improved.
  - Feedback and discussions with Vector and dSpace
    - OpenSource relevance was understood and they also will engage
- ThreadX special interest group
  - Microsoft and other members created a ThreadX Interest Group some weeks ago (https://projects.eclipse.org/interest-groups/threadx-interest-group)
  - Safety certified RTOS, which was quite expensive
    - Hesitation to create a group to refund the efforts
  - SIG should be a centre of gravity to follow up this discussion
    - Scope
      - To maintain existing certifications
      - Discuss on needed practices and policies to support also other projects
      - Support paperwork for certification
  - Steven
    - ThreadX is not only automotive
  - Certification will be developed on the example of ThreadX and can then be applied also to other projects
  - Sharon will provide a definition of SIG to get a better understanding
- Reference SDV distribution
  - Harman is hiring on this topic and will contribute
  - Already started with blueprints
  - Complete working software ecosystem
  - Steven will set up a meeting with Heiko to introduce already available initiatives

- Harman is internally working on a SDV distribution and wants to contribute this approach to EF
- o Getting OEMs on board
  - Necessary to get gravity in the Eclipse SDV WG
- o Information about Senior exec group
  - Michael is motivating OEM's to participate in Eclipse SDV
