- Resolved, the Steering Committee approved the March 12, 2021, Minutes

Membership Meeting Reflection and Next Steps

- Starting small projects to promote value-adding ideas
- Guaranteeing the origin of sustainable green vs. non-green energy as first thought
- Kick-off with use cases presentation from Steering Committee Members about Energy Projects to enhance exchange and focus between Members
- Next Steps: Contact organizations to start discussions

Vaccine & Disposable Identities Initiative

- Focus on disposable identity: move Covid Passport initiative forward to provide governments with an alternative to the centralized model soon enough

- Current short-term solution ideas to be found: Digital Covid Passport in App (Barcode), which, however, is still an opposite of a fully self-sovereign solution
- Long-term solution: Establishment of disposable identity (e.g. new identity for each bus change)
- Next Steps: Talking to Participants about Covid-Passport Initiative Development
- Assessment within a month to see where we are and plan next steps
- Parties already have expressed interest in integrating such a solution
- Idea: Foundation can provide Framework and core Tech and aim for partners to build an end solution

Projects in Energy

- Potential project Idea: GID tracking energy from specific assets, and Smart Contracts for ensuring secure operations; Optimization of Electric Vehicle Charging; Roaming and Interaction between Machines
- GAIA-X: Six Use cases will be published by the end of march
DID as an important concept
The first set of software (alpha version) could be implemented at some point this year as standards will be released soon
The aim to foster compliance with early implementation of the standards
The Catalog entails all basics for Federation services needed (amongst others Identity access)
Idea: Building little projects on top of that core software
