  - Eclipse 4.3
  - CDT 8.2
- Improvements to target configuration framework
- Improvements to monitoring framework
- Many enhancements to synchronized projects
- Updated support XSEDE systems

#### **APIs**



- Major API changes to support new/updated frameworks
- Retired many APIs that were not deprecated or not used
- Restructured plugins to follow Eclipse standards
- New 7.0 interfaces are Eclipse quality
- Version numbers incremented from 6.0 to 7.0
- Internal APIs marked as such

### **Defect Statistics**



- 303 bugs opened
- 266 bugs resolved/closed
- 80 new bugs

- All contributions (code, documentation, images, etc) have been committed by individuals who are either Members of the Foundation, or have signed the appropriate Committer Agreement; in either case,these are individuals who have signed, and are abiding by, the Eclipse IP Policy
- Major contributions have followed due diligence process
- All non-committer code contributions, including third-party libraries, have been documented in the release and reviewed by the Foundation's legal staff
