Minutes for March 5, 2024

Approve Minutes of February 20, 2024 Meeting

Motion: Approve Minutes of February 20, 2024. Martin moves and Jonah seconds. No objection to unanimous approval.

Welcome to Thomas Froment

Warm welcome to our new program manager Thomas Froment + a quick introduction from himself. Awesome to have you on board!!!

Update on 2f2 from last week (Feb 27)

Johannes gives a quick summary of the f2f meeting from last week. Slides created and presented from Mark during the hybrid part of the meeting: LINK TBD

Heads-up: there will be a somewhat quiet period while the various participants start to work on the SWT initiative. Johannes will also reach out to Alex (from the planning council) to chat about the SWT initiative.

Update on IDE WG Development Efforts

Thomas gives a quick update about the recent developments in the dev funding initiatives. The idea is to re-focus the dev funding initiative to contract someone to do technical work and technical guidance. The budget planning is not yet done for this, so it is not clear yet for how much contracting time we can aim for.

We stop doing new individual contracting for specific tasks, existing contracts are progressing.

Clarification: release engineering related contracts should continue as planned. There are smaller, critical issues, but the planning council was very clear to focus on the long-term contracting of this technical person.

Planning council priorities - update from last meeting

Jonah gives a quick update on the additional runner, but people from the companies and technical EF staff are already working on this and the solution is around the corner. There is no additional funding needed from the IDE WG.

Topic: OSGi slack workspace vs. Eclipse IDE WG slack workspace. Thomas summarizes the discussion that happened in Slack, Thomas suggests to use the IDE WG slack workspace. The other option is to use the existing Matrix chat system at Eclipse.

Side note: The limitations of Slack (30 days of history) will remain, there will be no Enterprise plan for Slack at Eclipse.

Jonah: the Eclipse IDE WG could allow projects to create groups/channels on the Eclipse IDE WG slack workspace - as a service.

Question comes up: where to host channels when working on specific topics (e.g. like the SWT initiative)?

Overall impression: let's not host a public channel (wherever) for random people to ask questions. Instead, we think about moving IDE WG channels from Slack to Matrix (because of the 30 day history limitation)

Action item: Thomas will prepare material for a decision whether to move to Matrix or not for the next meeting.
