Methodology




- An on-line questionnaire was sent to each Solution Member company (n=104).

How do you feel your business opportunities have changed over the past 6 months?





How do you feel your business opportunities have changed over the past 6 months?

■ Much worse ■ Somewhat worse ■ About the Same ■ A little improved ■ Much improved




How do you expect your use of Eclipse to change over the next 12 months?





Only good news here...no type of decrease in use

How valuable are the Eclipse Marketing activities or programs?




Marketing programs are neutral



How do you feel Eclipse 4.0 will impact your business?














