

- > 1/7th of all work on Mylyn



- Reference implementations for open source ALM tools used by the Eclipse community and for open ALM standards

Two kinds of projects

- > Frameworks: consumed by integrators, APIs used by the tools projects
- > Tools: consumed by end-users, have own branding and community
