- Q2 Results
 - \$57K revenue
 - Participants: Actuate, Google, Froglogic, Zero Turnaround, Vmware, Cloudsoft, Yatta, Xpolog, itemis
 - For month of June we sold 100% of capacity
- Q3 Outlook
 - We have stopped offering discounts to initial participants due to demand
 - \$46K revenue booked so far
 - Expect \$60K revenue booked
